Our vision is: ***At Lossiemouth High School, we champion kindness, high expectations and the belief that everyone can achieve their dreams.***

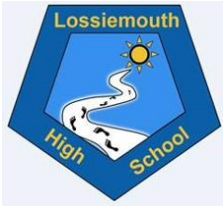
Our values are ***Ambition, Respect and Kindness***, captured in our motto: ***Be Kind, Dream Big!***
